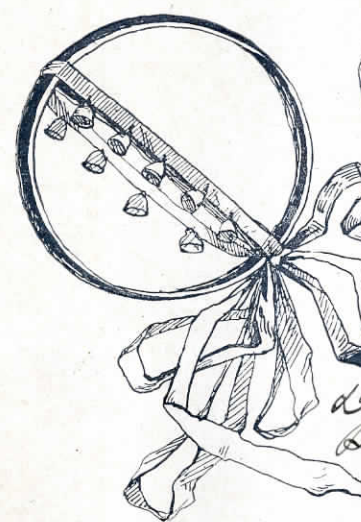

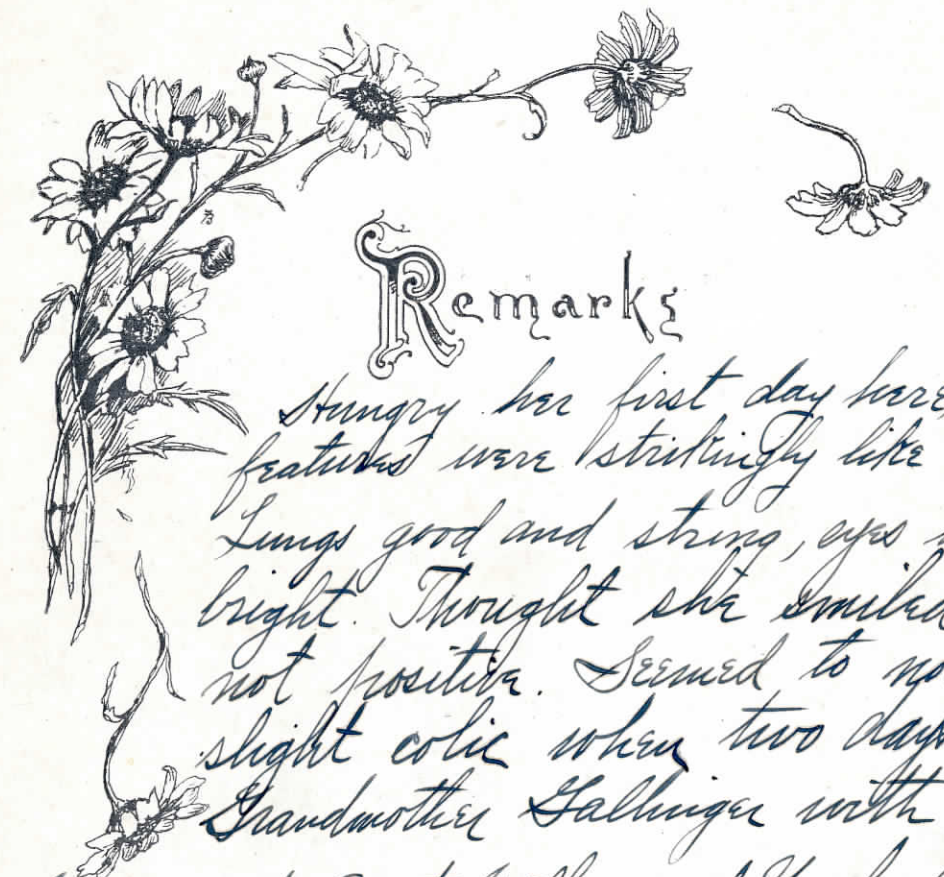

Weather lovely and cool in fact entire summer has been delightfully cool. Was carried up stairs to make her high minded and with hand full of money to make her wealthy when four days old. and down stairs when five days old. Baby was a very good baby no sleepless nights with her.
